



Fall Release

GROWING DEER

Fall Release is best seeded using a no-till drill or other seeding device and placing seed at a depth of 3/4" - 1". It can also be broadcast into areas with minimal plant competition such as a new plot or one where a seedbed has recently been prepared. Light incorporation or dragging can help with seed to soil contact but don't cover seeds with more than 3/4" of soil.

Plant 70 pounds per acre when seeding with a no-till drill or other planting implement and 100+ pounds per acre when broadcasting.

TIMING

Fall Release should be planted 6-8 weeks before the first average frost date during the fall and when there's adequate soil moisture or a forecast of rain.
